



**NOTICE OF SECOND PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED  
CHANGE TO THE WAKULLA COUNTY LAND DEVELOPMENT  
CODE**

The Wakulla County Board of County Commissioners will consider and proposes to adopt at a second Public Hearing on August 16, 2010 at 5:00 p.m., in the Commission Chambers, 29 Arran Rd., Crawfordville, FL 32327, the following proposed land development regulation by ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF WAKULLA COUNTY, FLORIDA; RELATING TO THE PROTECTION OF WETLANDS AND OTHER SURFACE WATERS IN THE COUNTY; REPEALING WAKULLA COUNTY ORDINANCE 2006-27 IN ITS ENTIRETY; PROVIDING DEFINITIONS; PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS; PROVIDING A PROCESS FOR APPROVAL OF DEVELOPMENT; PROVIDING FOR USE OF WETLANDS AND OTHER SURFACE WATERS; PROVIDING DESIGN STANDARDS; PROVIDING FOR MITIGATION AND RESTORATION OF DEGRADED WETLANDS AND OTHER SURFACE WATERS; PROVIDING PROCEDURE FOR ENFORCEMENT; PROVIDING PENALTIES; PROVIDING THAT PROCEDURES IN ORDINANCE ARE SUPPLEMENTAL AUTHORITY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

A copy of this ordinance shall be available for inspection by the public at 3093 Crawfordville Highway, Crawfordville, FL 32327. Interested parties may appear at the Public Hearing or submit comments and be heard with respect to the proposed ordinance. If a person decides to appeal any

decision made by the board, agency, or commission with respect to any matter considered at such meeting or hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and that, for such purpose, he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
