The Wakulla County Board of Commissioners is seeking qualified applicants for a full time Fire Lieutenant. Responsibilities include station assignments and staffing plans for staff firefighters; working with local volunteer fire chiefs determining projects in needs; of attention, ensure vehicles, equipment and stations are properly maintained; serve as incident commander at emergency scenes as needed until relieved by another qualified incident commander, supervise firefighters involved in firefighting and rescue activities, ensure firefighters compliance with safety rules regarding driving vehicles, wearing appropriate personal protective clothing and use of self contained breathing apparatuses, participate in inspection of hydrants, sprinkling systems and other elements of a fire prevention protection system, conduct voluntary home inspections, assist in the investigation of fire incidents, provide public education in fire prevention, including giving demonstrations and presentations before community groups, schools, and other organizations or institutions, perform other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS: Applicants must be 18 years of age; high school graduate; be willing to submit to a medical examination and pass an agility test; be a non-user of tobacco products for a minimum of one year preceding applications; be a resident of the State of Florida; hold a current and valid Firefighter II level certification; hold a current and valid EMT certification from the State of Florida including a valid CPR certification and 2 years experience as a paid or volunteer firefighter. Must also possess a current and valid Florida driver’s license.
